### GUIDELINES

#### BUS GUIDELINES

- 1. Keep noise at a tolerable level.

#### **CAMP GUIDELINES**

#### **GENERAL RULES:**

#### **DRESS CODE:**

#### **ALLOWED:**

Shorts must be fingertip length or longer.

Shirts: Modest tank tops/sleeveless (3 fingers in width). Cut-off sleeves must have a seam.

Swimsuits: Girls – Modest one-piece (no tankinis). Guys – Must wear a shirt to and from the pool.

No bare feet.

#### **NOT ALLOWED:**

No clothing with alcohol, tobacco, or suggestive content.

No clothing outside the dress code.

No cut-offs, short shorts, halter tops, spaghetti straps, racerbacks, crop tops, etc.

Cabin Rules

Rooms are private. No guys in girls' cabins and no girls in guys' cabins.

Lights out = quiet rooms. Be ready for bed before lights out.

No headphones or electronic games.

Stay away from sound and video equipment.
