BUS GUIDELINES

- 4. ROOMS ARE PRIVATE. No guys in girl's cabins, and no girls in guy's cabins.
- 5. Lights out means all the rooms must be quiet and lights are off. Changing clothes, brushing teeth and all pre-bed stuff must be done BEFORE lights out.
- 6. No headphones or electronic games of any kind are allowed.
- 7. Stay away from all sound and video equipment.
- 8. All older youth are expected to take care of and protect the younger youth. Older youth should look for opportunities to help, to share, and to encourage younger students.

The Following Beliefs are listed on Church Unlimited's website churchunlimited.com/beliefs

About God: God is the Creator and Ruler of the universe. He has eternally existed in three personalities: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and are one God.

It is the supreme source of truth for Christian beliefs and living. Because it is inspired by God, it is the truth without any mixture of error. It is inerrant (without error in its original form).

About Human Beings: People are made in the spiritual image of God, to be like Him in character. People are the supreme object of God's creation. Although every person has tremendous potential for good, all of us are marred by an attitude of disobedience toward God called "sin." This attitude separates people from God and causes many problems in life.

About Salvation: Salvation is God's free gift to us, but we must accept it. We can never make up for our sin by self-improvement or good works. Only by trusting in Jesus Christ as God's offer of forgiveness, can anyone be saved from sin's penalty. When we turn from our self-ruled life and turn to Jesus in faith we are saved. Eternal life begins the moment one receives Jesus Christ into his life by faith.

About Eternal Security: Because God gives us eternal life through Jesus Christ, the true believer is secure in that salvation for eternity. If you have been genuinely saved, you cannot "lose" it. Salvation is maintained by the grace and power of God, not by self-effort of the Christian. It is the grace and keeping power of God that gives us this security.
