# GUIDELINES

## BUS GUIDELINES

1. Keep noise to a tolerable level on the bus.

## CAMP GUIDELINES

1. NO ONE MAY LEAVE the boundaries of Camp Zephyr.
2. No public display of affection during camp. This week is meant for you to focus on the LORD, not on each other.
3. Please honor camp dress code.
  - Do's
    - All shorts must be fingertip length or longer
    - Shirts: modest tank tops or sleeveless (3 fingers in width) Cut off sleeves must have a seam.
    - Swimsuits - Girls: modest one piece no tankinis; Guys: must wear a shirt walking to & from pool
    - No bare feet
  - Don'ts
    - No clothing displaying alcoholic drinks, tobacco products, or suggestive sayings
    - No clothing outside of dress code
    - No cut offs, short shorts, halter tops, spaghetti-straps, tank tops, racer backs, crop tops, etc.
4. ROOMS ARE PRIVATE. No guys in girl's cabins, and no girls in guy's cabins.
5. Lights out means all the rooms must be quiet and lights are off. Changing clothes, brushing teeth and all pre-bed stuff must be done BEFORE lights out.
6. No headphones or electronic games of any kind are allowed.
7. Stay away from all sound and video equipment.
8. All older youth are expected to take care of and protect the younger youth. Older youth should look for opportunities to help, to share, and to encourage younger students.
